Please Note: Frames with outside dimensions larger than 16x20 inches will NOT be eligible for judging. Due to space limitations, we cannot guarantee that large prints will even be displayed.

Bring photo(s) (maximum of 2) and completed registration form to the

between 5:00 – 7:00 pm
Thursday, September 3rd or Friday, September 4th

- 1) Maximum of 2 prints per person accepted for judging.
- 2) Prints must be framed with wire attached and ready to hang on pegboard 'S' hooks.
- 3) Photo(s) must be the original art of the entrant.
- 4) Name and phone number must be on the back of each print.
- 5) Contestants may be residents of the City of Greenbelt or surrounding communities.
- 6) Photos should be picked up on Monday at 4:00 pm. Photographs not picked up within two weeks after the Labor Day Festival shall be forfeited.
- 7) All subjects must be in harmony with the standards of the Greenbelt Community and the Labor Day Festival Committee.
- 8) Please do not leave your registration forms or photos at the Community Center or Library.
